



## **2024 ASM International Albuquerque Chapter Scholarship**

### **Purpose:**

ASM International acts as the world's principal materials information society, and aims to “gather, process, and disseminate materials information globally, through education, networking, and professional development for members”. This scholarship aims to advance the goals of ASM International by improving access to education, networking, and professional development opportunities for materials scientists and engineering students studying within the region covered by the ASM International Albuquerque Chapter (Central and Northern New Mexico).

### **Who May Apply:**

Undergraduate and graduate students attending a New Mexico university or college and seeking a degree in STEM fields with an interest in materials science and engineering. Applicants must have, at minimum, one full semester on their transcript at the time of this posting and have at least a semester remaining before graduation as of January 2024, to be considered. Applications from previous awardees will not be accepted.

### **Award Selection:**

This is a merit-based scholarship where students will be evaluated upon their academic, leadership, and/or research achievements, as well as their interest in materials science and engineering. Keeping with [ASM International's pledge](#) to increase access and inclusion for present and future members, the selection process will take into consideration each applicant's unique life experience, background, and plans for the future.

The Albuquerque Chapter aims to distribute \$2,000 in funds for early bachelor's students (first and second year) and \$2,000 for experienced bachelor's students (three or more years). Additional funds may be distributed at the graduate level for students without full financial support from their research or academic institutions via RA/TA/fellowships. The ASM International Albuquerque Chapter reserves final discretion over award amounts and number of awardees.
